**Indigenous Peoples' Day ~ October 14, 2024**

Indigenous Peoples' Day has been touted as a replacement for Columbus Day for decades, but the movement never got much traction on a nationwide scale. Now, however, with increased awareness of colonizers' atrocities against Native Americans and Indigenous people of what eventually became the United States, Indigenous Peoples' Day has seen a groundbreaking amount of support. Here is what you need to know about Indigenous Peoples' Day and why it is so important — and why many feel that the man credited with discovering America may deserve to be stripped of his celebratory day.

Indigenous Peoples' Day is a day to recognize Indigenous people and the contributions they have made to history, as well as to mourn those lost to genocide and Western colonization—and to remember that Native Americans were here long before European settlers showed up on our shores. In 1977, the United Nations International Conference on Discrimination Against Indigenous Populations in the Americas proposed that Indigenous Peoples Day replace Columbus Day.

Indigenous Peoples' Day is more a day of recognition and mourning than of outright celebration. Great ways to commemorate Indigenous Peoples' Day are to educate yourself and others on Indigenous and Native American culture, and their contributions and history.
