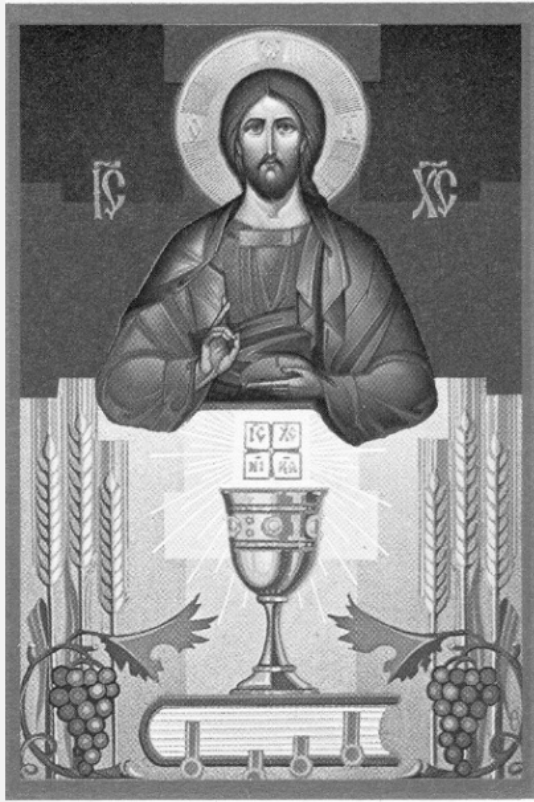

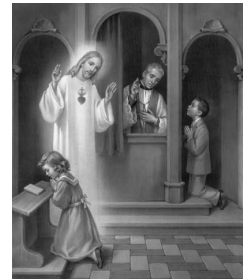

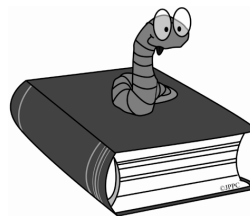
The Sacrament of Reconciliation
